

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Property Management Review uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit <https://propertymanagement-review.com/>. It should be read together with our Privacy Policy.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files stored on a browser or device when a website is visited. Cookies and similar technologies can be used to provide essential Website functionality, remember visitor preferences, understand Website performance and measure how visitors interact with pages.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly necessary cookies are required for essential Website functionality, security or recording privacy and cookie preferences. These cookies generally cannot be disabled through our consent tool because the Website requires them to respect the choices you make.

Analytics and performance cookies help us understand how visitors use Property Management Review, including which pages are visited, session activity, traffic sources, devices and Website performance.

Functional cookies may remember settings or preferences that enhance Website functionality.

Advertising or targeting cookies, if used, may help measure campaigns or understand interactions across websites. Such cookies are not treated as strictly necessary and are subject to applicable consent requirements.

3. Cookie Consent Management

Property Management Review uses CookieScript to manage cookie preferences. CookieScript may place a strictly necessary cookie called CookieScriptConsent to remember whether a visitor accepted, rejected or customised cookie categories.

CookieScript allows consent duration to be configured. The current live cookie declaration and Cookie Settings interface on the Website should be treated as the most current record of cookies detected and used.

4. Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics to understand Website traffic and usage. Google Analytics may use cookies including:

- `_ga` - used to distinguish users. Default expiry may be up to two years.
- `_ga_<container-id>` - used to maintain session state. Default expiry may be up to two years.

Google Analytics may collect information such as session statistics, approximate geographic information, device and browser information and Website interaction data. Where required by applicable law, analytics storage is controlled according to the visitor's consent choice.

5. Google Tag Manager

We may use Google Tag Manager to manage scripts and measurement technologies used on the Website. Google Tag Manager is principally a tag-management system. Technologies deployed through it, such as analytics tools, may themselves use cookies or collect information. Those technologies remain subject to the cookie preferences applicable to their category.

6. Microsoft Clarity

We use Microsoft Clarity to understand how visitors interact with the Website and improve usability. Clarity may process interaction information such as clicks, scrolling, page navigation and session activity and may use cookies including:

- `_clck`
- `_clsk`
- Depending on Microsoft's implementation and the visitor's browser/session, additional Microsoft cookies such as CLID, ANONCHK, MR, MUID or SM may also be used.

These cookies can support analytics, session continuity and related Microsoft functionality. Where consent is required, Clarity's non-essential cookie functionality is controlled according to the visitor's consent status.

7. Current Cookie List

Because cookies and provider configurations can change over time, the exact current cookie names, providers, categories and expiration periods should be displayed through the live Cookie Settings / Cookie Declaration generated by our consent management system.

That live declaration should take precedence over examples listed in this Policy where a provider has subsequently changed its technology.

8. Managing Your Choices

When required by applicable law, optional cookies will not be activated unless the appropriate consent has been provided. Visitors may accept optional cookies, reject optional cookies, or select individual cookie categories.

You may change or withdraw your preferences at any time by selecting Cookie Settings on the Website. You can also manage cookies through your browser settings. Blocking certain technologies may affect some non-essential Website features.

9. Third-Party Technologies

Third-party providers may process data according to their own privacy policies and service terms. Our use of a third-party technology does not mean that Property Management Review controls all aspects of that provider's independent processing. Further information about personal data processing is available in our Privacy Policy.
